Hands-on-Training Program at Niramaya Vermicompost, Dehradun



School of Agricultural Sciences and Forestry, Sardar Bhagwan Singh University, Dehradun organized a Hands-on-Training program at Niramaya Vermicompost, Dehradun for B. Sc

Agriculture final year students from 27th June to 5th July 2022.

During the program, students interacted with Mr. Vikramaditya Singh the owner of the Plant and learned about the use of earthworms in compost. Mr. Vikramaditya Singh enlightened the students about the use and benefits of jeevaamrit with vermicompost and different organic pesticides such as neemastra and agneyastra. Students also prepared organic vegetables using vermicompost. After completing the training, students also acquire business skills for organic farming. The Hands-on-Training program was arranged by Mr. Anil Panwar (Coordinator, Department of Agriculture Sciences and Forestry) and Dr. Deepika Chauhan as a part of the student's course curriculum during the summer vacation.

ONE DAY WORKSHOP ON GaitON ANALYSIS SYSTEM



Sardar Bhagwan Singh University, Dehradun organized a workshop on GaitON analysis system for Master in Physiotherapy first-year students on Monday, 01st August. Mr. Siddharth Hans Co-Founder & Product Head of GaitON was present in the workshop as a resource person. Prof. Maneesh Arora (Dean Students Welfare) and Prof. Reena Kumari (Head of the Department, School of Physiotherapy and Allied Health)welcomed the dignatory.

Mr. Siddharth Hansen lightened the students about how GaitON system analyzes gait abnormalities. He also mentioned that GaitON system monitored gait changes through muscle imbalances using kinematic graphs and other temporal parameters. Then he demonstrated the system in detail. Mr. Siddharth Hans encouraged and wished all the participants for their bright future. Students learned about various instruments of weather forecasting such as Barometer Radar, Anemometer, wind Vanes, Hygrometers, Rain gauges etc.

Later an informative talk on Advance Technologies and Techniques of Weather and Climate was delivered by Dr. Rohit Thapliyal (Scientist Indian Meteorological Department). Students also learned about the rainfall prediction system.
