Is Donating Plasma Safe?

Donating does a lots of good. Blood plasma is required for many medical conditions. These include treatments for immunological disorders, hemorragic conditions, wound healing and respiratory disorders as well as blood transfusions. Plasma donation is to collect enough plasma necessary for medical treatments. Donating plasma is mostly a safe process, but side effects do exist. Plasma is a component of your blood. To donate plasma, blood is withdrawn from your body and proceed through a machine that separates and collect the plasma. The other components of the blood such as the red blood cells are infused back to the patient.

Possible Risks and Wellness Tips

- 1. Protein Replacement with amino acid: Dietary and supplemental amino acid help building plasma protein supply.
- 2. Fatigue, Dehydration and Dizziness: Replenish your water and electrolytes to minimize feeling of dizziness and dehydration.
- 3. Bruising and Pain: Give your body time to heal from needle punctures by taking it easy.
- 4. Infection: Help your Immune system prevent infection with natural immunity aids and know when to see a doctor.
- 5. Arterial Puncture: Be sure to alert your technician if you think something is wrong at your puncture site.
- 6. Citrate Reaction: During a plasma donation, the technician will infuse a substance known as an anticoagulant into the blood collected in the plasma. This anticoagulant prevent blood clot in the body. Citrate binds calcium molecules. Because this effect is small and temporary, most people experience no side effects from citrate. However, a small number of people who donate plasma experience what's called a "Citrate reaction" results from the temporary loss of calcium.

Donating plasma is mostly a safe process with little side effects which can be treated. You can give plasma twice in any 7 day period, but no more than once in 48Hr.
