Department of Biochemistry and Biotechnology conducted Expert Lecture Series I on 6th November'2023. Two experts, Dr. Jay Prakash Verma from Banaras Hindu University, Varanasi, and Dr. Giridhar Babu Anam from Yeungnam University, South Korea, delivered the talks. Dr. Verma gave an expert talk on the topic "Phytomicrobiome as Bioinoculant for sustainable crop productivity", and highlighted the different types of plant growth promoting bacteria, and described the role of phyto microbiomes in sustainable agriculture for drought, disease resistance etc.The second resource person, Dr. Giridhar Babu Anam, enlightened the session with a talk on "Freshwater Ecosystem under Siege: A deep dive into cyano bacterial blooms and remedial research. He especially highlighted cyanobacteria blooms and their poisoning into the aquatic system. Further he also described the role of phage in cleaning cyanobacterial blooms. He also described the role of artificial intelligence and molecular methods. The event was inaugurated by Prof (Dr) J.Kumar, the Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor who delved into the applications of bioinoculants for sustainable agriculture and the threats cyanobacteria blooms poses on the aquatic systems.
